Barrett will soon meet her new Morgan horse, CBMF Phoenix (DBA Street Talk x Treble's Wild Memories), graciously donated by Ann Hailey of Copper Beech Morgan Horse Farm in New Albany, Ohio.

A seventh grader, Barrett is the daughter of Chris and Cathy Barrett. She likes riding, playing soccer and the piano, and running.
