



We offer a variety of programs that challenges members to learn, become involved, to develop competence as well as making friends and memories for a lifetime.

Horsemastership Program

This program is designed to help you become well-rounded, competent riders. Five levels are designed to increase your knowledge of the Morgan horse and horsemanship skills. You receive certificates and special prizes each time you complete a level.

AMHA Homeschooling Program

AMHA teamed up with A Journey Through Learning to give students a hands-on, educational project about Morgan horses. Four homeschooling lapbooks are available for purchase, and the first book is free for AMHA members! Core subject matter includes Art, English/Poetry, Healthcare, Logical Thinking, History, Literature, Math, Science, Social Studies, and Writing.

AMHA/UPHA Open Gate Learning Center

This is an on-site study and learning center for young riders competing at the Grand National & World Championship Morgan Horse Show®. Youth can stay on top of their academic requirements in a structured learning environment supervised by a professional teacher who can provide academic support for students.

Youth Clubs

AMHA offers exciting club contests and awards for AMHAY Clubs. Club contests are a great way to generate camaraderie amongst club members and learn new skills along the way.

Youth Council

The AMHA Youth Council is composed of 17 members, each selected for his or her devotion to the breed, creativity, and professionalism. We welcome all youth interested in governance and leadership roles to run for the positions that form the Executive Committee.

AMHA Open Competition Program

The AMHA Open Competition Program rewards members competing with their Morgans against other breeds. Within this program Junior Exhibitors are presented with Year-End Awards (1st-6th place) in six divisions. The overall Junior Exhibitor Champion of each division has the opportunity to be recognized at the AMHA Annual Convention.

AMHA Youth of the Year Program

Youth of the Year Contests reward those well-versed in horsemanship skills. Contests consist of a written exam, oral presentation, judging contest, and horsemastership pattern. The winner can customize their prize package valued at \$3,500. Local and regional contests are open to youth of all ages, but youth aged 14 and older must qualify to compete in Oklahoma.

AMHA Junior Invitational

This event takes place in Oklahoma City during the Grand National & World Championship Morgan Horse Show® each year. Open to all youth under the age of 13 with no qualifying necessary. The invitational includes two parts: a speech component with an interview and a judging contest with reasons. Juniors are welcome to participate in one or both components. Awards for 1st through 6th place are given for each component in addition to Champion and Reserve Champion awards based on the highest combined scores.



AMHA Youth Achievement Award

Youth will earn points in a variety of categories that includes youth program participation, breed promotion and community service. Award winners are recognized at the AMHA Annual Convention.
