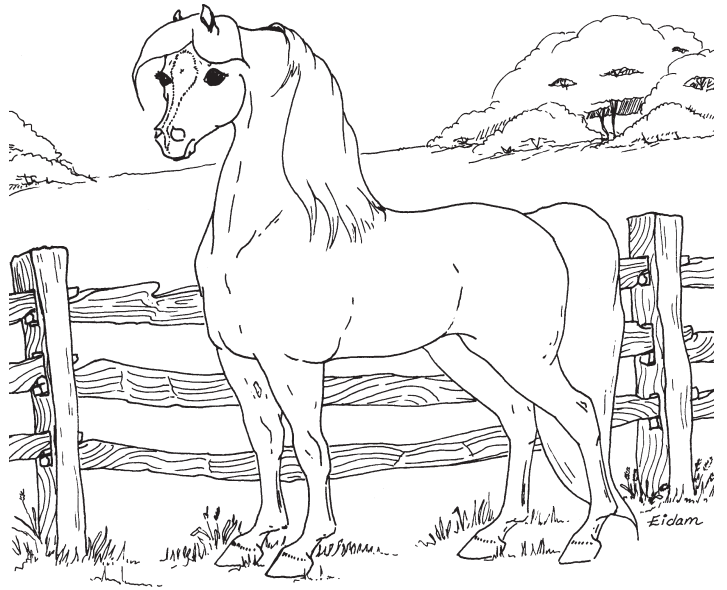


Morgan Horse Facts

- ◆ Justin Morgan was born in 1789.
- ◆ All Morgans today trace to Justin Morgan.
- ◆ The Morgan is the only American breed with foundation sires born before 1800. They are America's first breed!



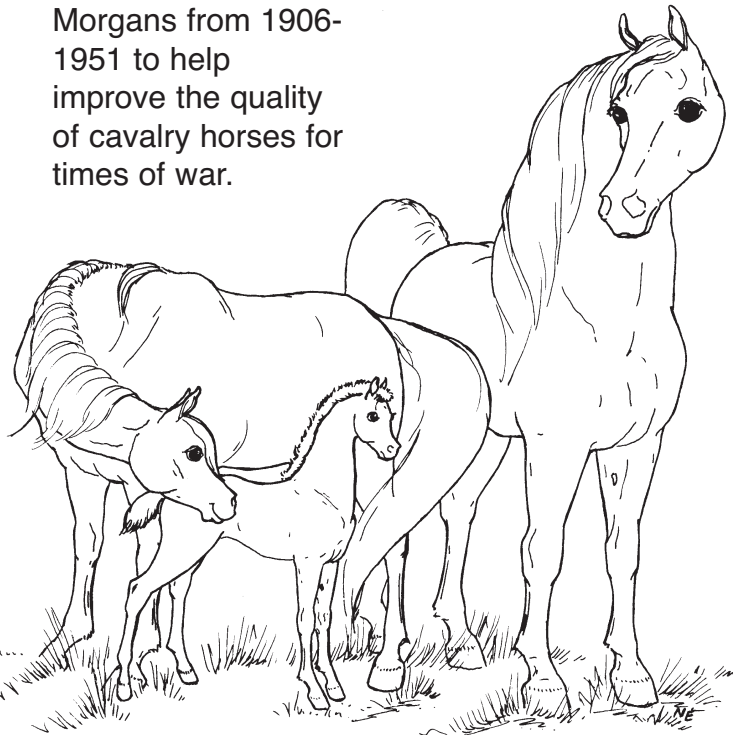
- ◆ Morgans were the favorite breed of the U.S. Cavalry because of their stamina, common sense, and ability to thrive on limited rations.

- ◆ The U.S. Government bred Morgans from 1906-1951 to help improve the quality of cavalry horses for times of war.

- ◆ Morgans are found in the foundation lines of the American Saddlebred, the Tennessee Walker, and the American Quarter Horse.

- ◆ Morgans are the state animal of Vermont and Massachusetts.

- ◆ Morgans stand 14.2-15.2 hands with some horses taller or shorter.



- ◆ Morgans are successful in all styles of riding and driving.

- ◆ Carriage, dressage, jumping, reining, trail, and the show ring are just a few of the places you can find Morgans winning today.

- ◆ Morgan coat colors include Bay, Black, Brown, Chestnut, Palomino, Buckskin, and Gray.

- ◆ Morgans have upright necks, short backs, and powerful hindquarters.
