Western Dressage

- Refer to Open Competition Program (under Programs menu item on AMHA home page) for current Open Competition Guidelines for eligibility, enrollment, point charts, medallion information, and instructions to enter results online.
- Awards are provided in each of 6 divisions:
 - o Introductory
 - o Basic
 - o First Level
 - o Second Level
 - o Third Level
 - Fourth Level & above
- Only tests judged by USEF-licensed dressage or western dressage judges will be applied toward medallions.
- Names of judges MUST be provided at the time of results submission.
- Rail classes in this discipline are eligible for submission, but must be submitted in the General category of Open Shows. Points for rail classes do not apply to the Dressage Division awards but rather to the Open Shows Division awards.
- Year-end awards are determined by converting percentages from test scores at the same level to point values using the chart below. Please submit your placing as well as your score when entering your results online in case of ties. Scores may be verified by WDAA. All test scores must be 60% or higher.

- Medallions are earned according to the following criteria:
 - Bronze is awarded when the horse has earned at least 200 points with at least 5 tests submitted at Level 1 or higher
 - Silver is awarded when the horse has earned at least 300 points with at least 5 tests submitted at Level 2 or higher
 - Gold is awarded when the horse has earned at least 500 points with at least 5 tests submitted at Level 3 or higher
 - Platinum is awarded when the horse has earned at least at least 700 points with at least
 5 tests submitted at Level 4 or higher
