

Dressage (awards at each level)

- Refer to Open Competition Program (under Programs menu item on AMHA home page) for current Open Competition Guidelines for eligibility, enrollment, point charts, medallion information, and instructions to enter results online.
- Awards are provided in each of 10 divisions:
 - Beginner/Schooling Dressage
 - Training Level
 - First Level
 - Second Level
 - Third Level
 - Fourth Level
 - Prix St. Georges
 - Intermediate I
 - Intermediate II
 - Grand Prix
- The Beginner/Schooling Dressage category is for Intro level tests judged by USEF-licensed dressage judges or L graduates and tests at other levels judged by “L” graduates. Scores earned at the Beginner/Schooling Dressage category are not applicable toward a dressage medallion.
- Names of judges MUST be provided at the time of results submission.
- Year-end awards are determined by averaging 5 scores at same level. At least one of the 5 tests submitted must be at the highest test of the level (e.g. Training Level 3). Please submit your placing as well as your score when entering your results online in case of ties. Scores may be verified. Only those participants that submit a minimum of 5 scores will be eligible to receive awards in the Dressage division.
- Medallions are earned according to the following criteria:
 - Bronze: 8 scores for Training or First level tests completed in at least 5 shows with at least 4 different judges. At least 2 scores must be from First level. All scores must be 60% or higher.
 - Silver: 8 scores for Second, Third, and Fourth level tests completed in at least 5 shows with at least 4 different judges. At least 2 scores must be at Fourth level. All scores must be 60% or higher.
 - Gold: 8 scores for Prix St. Georges through Intermediate II level tests completed in at least 5 shows with at least 4 different judges. At least 2 scores must be at the Intermediate II level. The final average score must be at least 60%.
 - Platinum: 8 scores at Grand Prix level tests completed in at least 5 shows with at least 4 different judges. The final average score must be at least 60%.
