

Eventing

- Refer to Open Competition Program (under Programs menu item on AMHA home page) for current Open Competition Guidelines for eligibility, enrollment, point charts, medallion information, and instructions to enter results online.
- Eventing competitions include jumper derbies, cross-country tests, combined tests, starter event tests, eventing equitation tests, young event horse tests, and horse trials.
 - Jumper derbies are considered unsanctioned
 - All other competitions provided above are sanctioned by USEF/USEA
- Year-end points are calculated for each event according the following scoring chart:

	1 st	2 nd	3 rd	4 th	5 th	6 th	Participation
Sanctioned	12	10	8	7	6	4	2
Unsanctioned	7	6	5	4	3	2	1

- Medallions for Eventing
 - Placing 1st–10th at one sanctioned horse trial (3 phases): 4 points
 - Completing one sanctioned cross-country tests, combined tests, starter event tests, eventing equitation tests, or young event horse tests: 2 points
 - Completing an unsanctioned event (any level) or in a jumper derby: 1 point
 - ✓ Bronze medallion: 40 points
 - ✓ Silver medallion: 100 points
 - ✓ Gold medallion: 160 points
 - ✓ Platinum medallion: 240 points
