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MISSION

The AMHA Youth Programs are designed to help our youth become educated horsemen who are civically minded, passionate advocates of the Morgan horse as well as advocates of horse sport and horse ownership.

RULES

- 1. This program is open to AMHAY members, 21 years and under, who are interested in learning more about Morgans and safe horsemanship while participating in Morgan promotion and community service.
- 2. There are five levels of achievement once AMHA Youth membership has been established:
 - 1) Bulrush
 - 2) Woodbury
 - 3) Sherman
 - 4) Black Hawk
 - 5) Justin Morgan

- 3. Level requirements do not need to be completed at the same time, although you must complete one level before progressing to the next.
- 4. Complete the checklist at the end of this packet and email to nicole@morganhorse .com
- 5. Members may work on the merit levels as individuals or in a youth Team. The first two levels may be completed with any horse, but third level and above needs to be completed with a Morgan horse.

OBJECTIVE

This level of the AMHA Youth Merit Program requires you to choose one particular field of the equine industry and build an extensive business plan for a career in the chosen field, or a thesis based on research in said field. This level of the program is open to AMHA Youth members over the age of 16 only (According to USEF age rules ending by December 31st of that year.)

To complete this Level:

- -Submit Application
- -A Mentor will be chosen and a meeting with mentor, applicant, AMHA Staff and members of review committee will be scheduled.
- -Applicant will explain their project, what they plan to include and how they plan to present final draft. (i.e. written, multimedia, etc) Staff and review committee will ask questions and make suggestions at this time.
- -Timeline for progress updates and completion will be determined at this time.
- -Applicant will submit project, committee will review and respond with requests for more information if needed and then a final meeting for applicant to present and defend the project is held.
- -Applicant will also be required to pass a comprehensive test covering all topics in the five levels of the Merit Program.
- -Applicant will also be required to perform an additional 15 hours of community service.

OBJECTIVE

To complete the Justin Morgan Merit Level, a comprehensive test covering all topics in the five levels of the Merit Program must be completed. The test will include the following topics:

- Basic Barn and Safety Rules


