(Total possible score, 6 points.)

**3.** List your competitive dressage accomplishments on a Morgan(s). Include any national or regional year-end awards, such as: United States Dressage Federation Horse of the Year, Junior Young Rider or All-Breeds Awards; American Morgan Horse Association Open Competition awards; US Equestrian Regional awards; Morgan Dressage Association Awards of Excellence or Regional Championships; Morgan or dressage club awards; or any individual competition level championships. Include the Morgan's name, award, level and year won.
