

The Perpetual Sportsmanship Award

In Memory of Walter Bouchier Devereux, III

Criteria: Awarded to the horseman or horsewoman who personifies the ideals of the current sportsman's charter through commitment and dedication to the sport. An individual may be nominated multiple times more than once but may only win this award one time.

Selection of Winner: Nominations are submitted by Affiliated National Association Presidents and Executive Directors. The nominees with biographical information are returned to the National Officers for decision.

Award: The recipient will be recognized and the trophy given at the Pegasus Awards Dinner during the annual meeting.

Timeline: Nominations will be accepted beginning **in September**. Affiliated Association Presidents and Executive Directors are solicited for nominations. Once all nominations are in, the nominees are forwarded to the National Officers. The winner is notified of the results via email and will be recognized at the Pegasus Awards Dinner during the annual meeting.
