



AMHA Champion Title Program

Guidelines

Overview

Established in 2012, the AMHA Champion Title program encourages Morgan Show Champions to enroll to receive the titles of CH (Champion) and GCH (Grand Champion).

Prerequisites

To be eligible for enrollment, horses must be registered through AMHA and owners must have a current AMHA membership.

Cost

Cost of enrollment is \$100 which includes the current year points. There is an additional \$50 per each prior year the horse has earned points toward the title. Once enrolled, there is a \$50 annual fee until the enrolled horse either achieves the GCH title or the \$500 maximum program payment is met (which includes the initial enrollment fees).

Verification

There is an annual email sent to the owner of the enrolled horse in April that includes the current points status and an invoice for the annual fee. If it is thought that horse has achieved the CH or GCH at anytime during the year, please contact nikki@morganhorse.com for verification.

Awards

Once the CH or GCH has been achieved, AMHA will send a certificate of Achievement to the listed owner, the horse name will be updated in the registry with the appropriate title and the horse will be recognized on the AMHA Facebook page on “Work for it Wednesday.”

ONLY HORSES ENROLLED IN THE AMHA CHAMPION TITLE PROGRAM CAN USE THE CH OR GCH TITLE IN ADVERTISING OR AT HORSE SHOWS.

Point Accumulation

Horses can accumulate points toward the program in the following ways...

USEF & USEF Lite recognized competitions:

Championship: 2 points

Reserve Championship: 1 point

Grand National and World Championship Morgan Horse Show:

World Championship: 3 points

Reserve World Championship: 2 points

1st Place Grand National class: 2 points

2nd Place Grand National class: 1 point

High point awards given at USEF & USEF Lite sanctioned competitions count toward Champion Title points.

High Point Awards: 2 points

- All Championship classes must have a qualifier in order to accumulate points.
- Stake classes count as long as there is a qualifier.
- Equitation classes count as long as rider is recorded in horses records
- Classes that count MUST be of the same seat/discipline.
- Classes must be designated all Morgan.

Title Achievement

Champion (CH): Horse must have earned at least 15 points and 1 or more major *OR*

Has earned the Silver Medallion in the Open Competition program.

Grand Champion (GCH): Horse must have earned at least 30 points and 2 or more majors *OR* received the Gold or Platinum Medallion in the Open Competition program.

**A "Major" is a championship class (or Grand National class) won that had at least 4 entries complete the class*
